
The new press box is an added feature at the Championship Field this year. A new sound system was installed just in time for opening day.

Established in 1961, the NFL Punt, Pass and Kick (PPK) program is a national skills competition for boys and girls between the ages of six and 15. They compete separately against their peers in five separate age divisions (6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 and 14-15) in punting, passing and place kicking in a fun and engaging forum.

More than three million boys and girls participate in the PPK competitions around the country.
