## PAL Youth Selected for State PAL Girl of the Year Award!

OBPAL is pleased to announce that a member of our Youth Directors Program has been selected as the State of Florida recipient of the Police Athletic League Girl of the Year Award. Marissa Moss, a junior at Mainland High School, was selected for the award which is given to youth who exemplified community leadership through academic excellence and community volunteerism.

Ms. Moss has been an active member of the OBPAL program since the fourth grade and has taken part in various PAL activities. She has always been quiet and shy but very determined. Towering over most of the other girls, she joined the OBPAL basketball program in 2003.

Ms. Moss became active in the Youth Directors Program and has served as Vice President of the Ormond Beach Chapter of the YDC program since 2006. She is always willing to take the leading role to motivate others and her imagination has helped to create interesting program projects.

Marissa never misses an opportunity to earn points to attend the Youth Directors Conference and has assisted in Field Day, Cheerleading Competitions, Regional Basketball Tournaments and various other OBPAL and State of Florida PAL events. In 2008, Ms. Moss was elected to the Youth Advisory Council and has served there for three years. In 2010, she achieved her goal of being elected to the Youth Conference Committee adding to her participation in PAL programs. As a member of YDC, it was

necessary for Marissa to attend organizational meetings and assist in the creation of the activities for the YDC Conference. She was an important asset to the planning of the 2011 Conference.

In addition to PAL activities, Ms. Moss is the President of the Youth Usher Board of her church and in 2010 she was selected as the DMC Debutante Representative for the Allen Chapel AME Church. She also took third place in her church's Brain Bowl.

Ms. Moss participated on the Mainland Flag Football Team and was recognized as the 2010 Shut Down Specialist. She currently plays as the center for the Mainland High Girls Basketball Team. She is a determined and ambitious young lady and has been an honor roll student every semester since 2008 and has achieved the highest GPA in the Mainland High School Sports Science Academy. Additionally, she has earned a 3.98 GPA Basketball Recognition Award and maintains straight A's in Spanish.

Ms. Moss has blossomed into a very respectful young lady and has developed outstanding leadership qualities while participating in the Ormond Beach Police Athletic League. # Honoring Ruth Horan

On Tuesday, January 11th, at 7:30 p.m. in the Blue Room Studio of the Ormond Beach Performing Arts Center, a reception will be held honoring Ruth Horan in celebration of her 60 years as a Judo Sensei (instructor). In addition, Ms. Horan has taught Judo in Ormond Beach for 40 years.

Ms. Horan is the highest ranking person ever in Judo and a special Judo rank was created specifically for her. Her martial arts accomplishments include an 8<sup>th</sup> degree Black Belt, Honda Award for Highest Ranking Woman Ever in Judo, First Judo National Hall of Fame Award (1969), Outstanding Judo Coach Award (1980), U.S. Martial Arts Association Hall of Fame Award, and Judo Master of the Year (2005).


In addition to her numerous martial arts accomplishments, she authored "Judo for Women" which was published in 1965, has had newspaper articles written about her, including in the New York Times, and is the founder of the Ormond Beach Friends of Recreation, and Ormond Beach Friends of the Performing Arts Center.


# ***THE LEGENDS OF DOO WOP WITH A TWIST!***






