

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, to be eligible to enter the World Championship, a team must qualify in one of the official tour events, and have at least three players on the National Roster, who were on the roster of the team that qualified; and

WHEREAS, Memphis Dylan Parker, a seven-year old who attends Tomoka Elementary as a second grader, plays on a 3v3 soccer team, *Future Legends FC*, with five other players throughout Florida. The team qualified for the World Championship 3v3 Soccer Tournament, invitation only, after winning the National Championship in August 2009; and

WHEREAS, in the World Championship, Under 7 Division, there were 34 teams, seven from Florida and 27 from throughout the country. Future Legends played eight games over the three-day weekend and was undefeated throughout the tournament. The 34 teams were divided into gold and silver divisions. Future Legends won the World Championship in the Gold division; and

WHEREAS, at the Kick It 3v3 Championships, the top teams received championship awards and were given the opportunity to be honored in front of family, friends, fans, and players alike at the Kick It 3v3 Soccer World Championship Awards Ceremony held at Disney's Wide World of Sports Complex on January 18, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the boys exhibited passion and dedication which lead to their success while demonstrating good sportsmanship and following the sportsmanship challenge, "to behave with grace and honor, and show respect for fellow participants and officials, no matter if your fortunes are good or bad in the competition." (A. Genchi); and

WHEREAS, the City of Ormond Beach is very proud of the boys and their accomplishments and grateful to the organizers, coaches, volunteers, sponsors and everyone concerned for their contributions to the success of the players;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Fred Costello, Mayor of the City of Ormond Beach, Florida, do hereby proclaim February 3, 2010, as
