

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, to be eligible to enter the World Championship, a team must qualify in one of the official tour events, and have at least three players on the National Roster, who were on the roster of the team that qualified; and

WHEREAS, the Ormond Beach Bolts—*Andrew Acebal, Jesper Eriksson, Nicholas Grubel, Michael Hanna, and Matthew Heitman*--is an Under 6 Division 3v3 soccer team with five players from the Ormond Beach area. The team qualified for the World Championship 3v3 Soccer Tournament by finishing 4th place at the National 3v3 Soccer Tournament at Disney's Wild World of Sports Complex in August 2009; and

WHEREAS, in the World Championship, Under 6 Division, there were 28 teams, and the Ormond Beach Bolts beat teams from Colorado, Texas, and Indiana. They played six games over three days and finished 7th overall; and

WHEREAS, the boys exhibited passion and dedication which lead to their success while demonstrating good sportsmanship and following the sportsmanship challenge, "to behave with grace and honor, and show respect for fellow participants and officials, no matter if your fortunes are good or bad in the competition." (A. Genchi); and


