

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Hudson Technologies, formerly Hudson Tool & Die, is a United States manufacturer of precision engineered deep drawn, or seamless, metal enclosures and stampings located in Ormond Beach, employing over 200 people; and

WHEREAS, Hudson Technologies seamless metal cases enclose technology used in aviation, aerospace, commercial battery, electronic instruments and sensors, implantable medical devices, semi-conductor, and other industrial applications worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Hudson Technologies has a set of enduring values—Earn Trust, Learn by Doing, Work Together, and Steward Our Legacy—that form a framework that both inspires innovation and governs how the company changes and grows; and

WHEREAS, Hudson Tool & Die was founded in 1940 by Czech immigrant Charles Batka in Hudson County, New Jersey. In 1969, a second plant opened in Ormond Beach where all operations are now located. In 1984, it was purchased by JSJ, a privately held corporation based in Grand Haven, Michigan; and

WHEREAS, in 2007, Hudson Technologies completed a \$2 million, two-year conversion of its facility to an environmentally-sound cleaning system, putting Hudson Technologies at the leading edge of greener manufacturing in the deep draw industry as its manufacturing process produces no hazardous waste; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, Hudson Technologies was named "*Manufacturer of the Year*" by the Volusia Manufacturers Association, and in 2010, the City of Ormond Beach presented it with the Retention/Expansion Project Award for being a company that is investing in the community by improving and expanding its business; and


WHEREAS, today--Hudson Technologies is celebrating its 70th anniversary;
