

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Spinnaker Resorts, founded in 1982, has been in the timeshare business for over 25 years with a mission to provide family entertainment taking advantage of the ocean and beach in a beautiful family-friendly resort. Spinnaker Resorts is the owner of the Royal Floridian Resort, a landmark seven-story, Mediterranean-style oceanfront resort located at 51 South Atlantic Avenue in Ormond Beach; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, Spinnaker Resorts hired ConTech Restoration to undertake a \$6.4 million restoration project of Royal Floridian Resorts facility which ConTech completed in only a nine-month period; and
