## Enviro Camp

We'll make solar ovens, become crime scene investigators, and conduct all kinds of wild and wacky science experiments!

"I Dig History" week starts July 16th, and we'll see what we can "dig up" about the history of our area. Our week will include a visit to several local historical sites, and finding out about a shipwreck that took place right here in Ormond Beach. We can't wait to see what kind of treasures we can discover during our archeological dig! Children will take part in their own ancient Roman Olympic Games, complete with opening ceremonies and games including the shot-put and discus throw.

July 23rd begins "Project Planet" week where it's all about protecting our precious environment. A tree planting ceremony and making our own terrariums will be just some of the green activities planned. We'll learn about solar and wind

energy and how recycling can help save our planet. Kids will have a blast taking part in the "Can Can Carnival" complete with games, prizes, popcorn and snow cones.

Registration for our final week of camp which begins July 30th is already closed as it is now filled to capacity. 
