

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Florida 500 Club was founded by Ormond resident Liz Cocks in May 1990 with 61 fellow bowlers who voted on tournament rules, by-laws, and elected their first officers; and

WHEREAS, Liz Cocks was elected the first president and held that office until 2006 when she had to step down because of health reasons; and

WHEREAS, the first tournament was held in October 1990 in Daytona Beach with 322 bowlers. By 1992, there was a membership of 1,300. Florida 500 Club is still growing today with 4,543 bowlers statewide who have rolled a certified three-game scratch series of between 500 and 599 in league or tournaments to become eligible for membership in Florida 500 Club; and

WHEREAS, this year's Florida 500 Club State Bowling Tournament is hosted by Ormond Lanes at 260 North Highway US1;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ed Kelley, Mayor of the City of Ormond Beach, Florida, do hereby proclaim October 27 and 28, 2012, as the
