

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Doug Wigley has been a board member of the Ormond Beach Youth Baseball and Softball Association (OBYBSA) for 19 years, during which time he has served as League Director for all age groups at one time or another and has served as Commissioner of Baseball of OBYBSA for the last 12 years. He has coached in all levels of recreational baseball for 19 years and has coached AAU, USSA, American Legion and Golden Spikes competitive baseball for ten years. Under the leadership of Doug as the Commissioner of Baseball, the OBYBSA organization has gone from a deficit to being able to contribute \$40,000 to the City in the public/private cooperative effort to build the new T-ball fields at the Ormond Beach Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Doug has served the City on the Citizens Advisory Committee City Manager Search, Development Review Board, Planning Board, and Leisure Services Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Ormond Beach City Commission and city staff express their sincere appreciation to Doug Wigley for the dedicated service he has offered to Ormond Beach and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ed Kelley, Mayor of the City of Ormond Beach, Florida, do hereby proclaim March 1, 2013, as a day to dedicate the
