Memorial Day Remembrance

Hundreds of men, women and children will gather in Rockefeller Gardens on Monday, May 27th, in loving memory of those whose supreme sacrifice protect the privileges we enjoy as a nation. Our debt can never be paid as acknowledged by the increasing faithful citizens and visitors each year who attend the Memorial Remembrance Services.

Whether a guest feels the overwhelming pride that is common at this event or feels a tear rolling down their cheek as some do each year, the most meaningful tribute that can be paid to our fallen heroes is found in being among other caring citizens to honor those who years ago, or as recently as today, have made the supreme sacrifice.

Weeks of preparation by the volunteer Memorial Remembrance Committee and City staff each year has made this an increasingly popular and widely respected event.

Dignity, respect and love describe the humility with which this annual program is presented. The uncompromised purpose is to honor the selflessness and bravery with which over a million men and women throughout our history have laid down their lives for our freedom.

The program includes 90 minutes of heart grasping sights and sounds that start at 9 a.m. when Gordon Russell conducts the members of the Daytona Beach Concert Band. Janet Marnane, US Navy Commander (retired), will serve as the Memorial Remembrance moderator. Guest speaker will be Commander Theron "TC" Colbert, USNR (retired). Attendees will be welcomed by Ormond Beach Mayor Ed Kelley. The invocation will be rendered by Rabbi Howard Schwartz, US Army Major (retired) and the benediction by Chaplain Willie Branch.

Rockefeller Gardens will be filled with numerous military color guards and color corps. Additional groups, including Boy and Girl Scouts will join them.

Guests will be given a carnation on arrival at Rockefeller Gardens. A final tribute is rendered as they move forward in procession, to place their flower beside the Memorial Marker as a personal "thank you" to those who made the supreme sacrifice.

As the last flower is placed, we the free will have honored the fallen with love, humility and gratitude.

This annual Memorial Remembrance Service takes place at 9 a.m. on Monday, May 27, in Rockefeller Gardens, 25 Riverside Drive in Ormond Beach.

Rockefeller Gardens is at the southeast corner of Granada Boulevard (State Road 40) and Riverside Drive on the peninsula side of the Granada Bridge, and in front of The Casements. Parking will be available at The Casements, Fortunato Park, and the Ormond Memorial Art Museum.

FLOW is a standalone mobile office with technology to provide most motorists' needs. It provides drivers license/ID card change of address, renewals, replacements, and renewals and replacements of vehicle registration and disabled parking permits, as well as other needs. The only thing FLOW does not provide is for the drivers' license road test.

FLOW brings services to the local communities offering a convenience to citizens while saving them time and gas. The next date will be July 1st.




Life is Good at SONC


