The Casements is the honored recipient of a 1929 Atwater Kent table radio. The Kiel table radio is a handsome piece of furniture with a "hidden" working radio built inside the table. It is easy to imagine that such a quality, unique table may have been used by John D. Rockefeller, Sr., in this very house. The period between the late 1920's and the early 1940's was known as "The Golden Age of Radio." There was no television or even FM radio broadcasting during that time so AM radio was king. This Kiel radio is 100% American made and is original in all aspects. Our generous donors are Charles and Elizabeth Milton of Palm Coast. Mr. Milton is an avid radio collector.
