

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, since 1985, Prince of Peace's social services outreach ministry has provided food, temporary shelter, vouchers, clothing, bus fares, prescriptions, diapers and financial assistance to tens of thousands of poor and homeless people in Ormond Beach and Holly Hill. In 2012 alone, the Church helped over 5,200 families by distributing 6,400 bags of food, 1,100 shelter vouchers, and financial assistance for prescriptions, utility bills, bus passes and rent and mortgage payments; and

WHEREAS, the new Social Services building will allow them to expand their thrift shop operation, by bringing it to the parish campus and providing even more resources to help the poor and needy in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Social Services Ministry Center project, funded by the *Alive in Christ* campaign, is a 6,000 square foot building for the parish's Like New Shop thrift store. The project will be expanded in the future to include the church's food pantry and office for social services intake, counseling and group meetings, and a chapel; and


