



Boys Youth Basketball Registration

Registration for the Ormond Beach Youth Basketball Association will take place through November 7th for boys 8 -15 years old (as of September 1, 2013) at the City of Ormond Beach Leisure Services Department Registration Office which is located at 399 N U.S. 1. The registration office hours are Monday–Thursday, 7:30 a.m.–4:30 p.m., and Friday, 7:30 a.m.–3:00 p.m.

Registrations can also be completed online at www.ormondbeach.org if you have completed a Leisure Services Department General Information/Release and Waiver of Liability form this calendar year.

If you register prior to November 1st, your child will be enrolled in a free pre-season clinic to be held Saturday, November 2nd from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The fee for City of Ormond Beach residents is \$65.00 (proof of residency required) and \$98.00 for non-residents.

The season will run November 16, 2013, thru late February 2014. Games and practices will be played at the Nova Community Center Gymnasium and the South Ormond Neighborhood Center Gymnasium.

Coaches, Sponsors and League Directors are needed. All coaches will need to attend tryouts/skill assessments on November 9th and 11th.

The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles "Florida Licensing On Wheels" (FLOW) mobile unit will be at City Hall on Monday, October 28th, from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

FLOW is a standalone mobile office with technology to provide most motorists' needs. It provides drivers license/ID card change of address, renewals, replacements, and renewals and replacements of vehicle registration and disabled parking permits, as well as other needs. The only thing FLOW does not provide is for the drivers' license road test.

FLOW brings services to the local communities offering a convenience to citizens while saving them time and gas.

CHILD & BABYSITTING SAFETY TRAINING



The Ormond Beach Fire Department will be offering for the citizens of Ormond Beach a Child And Babysitting Safety (CABS) training program through the American Safety & Health Institute. The Department will be offering a CABS course on Saturday, November 9th, from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. in the training room at Fire Station #92, which is located at 189 S. Nova Road.

This course will provide young people with basic skill training and information that are necessary in caring for infants and children. This program will teach the importance of responsibility, recognizing an emergency, emergency action steps, personal safety, fire safety, water safety, infant care, basic first aid, choking management, and child/infant CPR. The program is designed for young people (ages 11-16) who will be babysitting or providing child and infant care. Participants will receive a CABS card upon successful completion of the course.

The cost of the training will be \$10/person and participants will receive a Child and Babysitting Safety packet. Class size is limited. Please contact Fire Administration at 676-3255 for information on registration. Participants may bring lunch, or may purchase lunch at eateries nearby. School dress code will apply.

Public Meeting Held at The Casements




