After much planning to find the perfect location, a memorial bench in honor of Jackie Burke, former Secretary to the City Manager, was recently installed at the Birthplace of Speed Park overlooking the beautiful Atlantic Ocean.

Jacqueline P. Burke, known as “Jackie” began working for the City of Ormond Beach in May of 1988 under Public Works Director Alan Gilbert and Human Resources Director Troy Alley. It was quickly apparent that Jackie was multi-talented and could handle any situation.

Over the years, Jackie also worked for Assistant City Manager and Public Works Director, Ted MacLeod and several City Managers including Bernie Murphy, Troy Alley, Eugene Miller, Isaac Turner and Joyce Shanahan. She was on top of most every situation going on in the city, knew just about everyone from citizens to business people and dignitaries who stopped in or called the City Manager’s office. She always took time to listen to citizens and co-workers in a kind and caring manner.

If one wanted to know what a talented, professional secretary can do, all one had to do was to watch Jackie at work. In addition to her busy schedule of keeping the City Manager on track with his/her meetings, handling travel plans for the City Manager and City Commission, publishing the Weekly Staff Report and Weekly Review, to name just a few, she competently handled any challenge or problem that came across her desk. She was well known for planning employee events, such as the City Hall Holiday Luncheon, Employee Appreciation Day, and Volusia League of Cities dinners. Jackie put her heart and soul into her job.

After 22 years of loyal service to the City of Ormond Beach and its citizens, Jackie retired in October of 2010. Sadly, she passed away in July 2012. Since Jackie loved sitting at the beach and looking out at the ocean, it was determined that the best way to thank her and honor her memory would be installing a memorial bench in a location that she would have enjoyed - a view looking out on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Employee of the Quarter for the fourth quarter of FY 2012-13 was awarded to our Criminal Investigations Division of the Ormond Beach Police Department. Recently, the Ormond Beach area was the victim of a local burglary ring. This “ring” committed twelve burglaries in the City and another two burglaries outside of the City. The residents of at least two of the homes targeted were home at the time of the burglaries.

This group of officers worked together and launched the initial investigation which resulted in the apprehension of two suspects, the clearance of twelve cases, and the recovery \$10,000 worth of stolen property on behalf of the victims.

Our Detective Division is comprised of highly trained and experienced officers. Combined, this group has over 104 years of law enforcement experience. Some of their specialized training consists of: homicide and death investigations, frauds, child abuse and abductions, sex crimes, narcotic investigations and crimes against the elderly.

On the personal side, seven of these fine detectives are husbands and wives, many are parents and some are even grandparents. As an organization we encourage our employees to have a healthy work/life balance and you may be interested to know that this group has many hobbies, including kayaking, fishing, many are football fans, some volunteer within our community, some are passionate bicyclists, and one of these fine detectives is the biggest fan of his 12-year old daughter’s competitive baton and dance team, and another detective is the coach of his son’s State champion travel baseball team.

Not only is the City of Ormond Beach lucky to have this group working hard to keep all of us safe each and every day, we are privileged to have these individuals as our neighbors and members of the community. These detectives are truly some of Ormond Beach Police Department’s finest and we are very fortunate to have them.




Levels Program at Gymnastics Center
