



Quarterly Commentary

The US equity markets shrugged off global political turmoil, tensions and sluggish economic growth here and abroad to produce a positive return last quarter. While small cap stocks, as represented by the Russell 2000 index, worked to come back from a two-month, 10% slide from early March to mid-May, many of the larger cap indices, such as the S&P 500, continued to break all-time highs over and over again. Around the same time, estimates for the US 1st Quarter 2014 GDP kept being revised lower, with the last in late June showing a negative 2.9% contraction, its worst retreat since breaking out of the recession in 2009.

Although Large Cap won the race last quarter, US Small-Mid Cap didn't fare too bad either. As measured by the Russell 2500 index, the market returned about 3.5% for the quarter, which gives it just under a 6.0% return for the year. At the beginning of the quarter, it seemed we would be in for a downward ride in the US Small-Mid Cap space as April finished with negative returns. But May turned positive and the accelerator really hit the floor in June. The leadership trend reversal from Value to Growth continued for the quarter and the Russell 2500 Value index now has nearly a 400 bps lead in return year-to-date (7.9% vs 4.0%) vs the 2500 Growth index. While Large Cap may have been the winner for the quarter, the Mid-Cap Value space remains in the lead year-to-date with a greater than 11.0% return. On a sector basis, Energy and Utilities were the right places to be in Small-Mid last quarter. Technology and Financials were among the wrong places to be, although both market sectors still delivered a positive return.

Specific to the GW Capital portfolio, we were pleased to outperform both the Russell 2500 Core and Value indices for the 2nd Quarter. The primary driver of outperformance was Issue Selection. Sector Allocation still had a positive contribution, just not as extensive as Issue Selection.

Starting with Sector Allocation, given our long-term overweight to Energy, it should be no surprise that our exposure to that sector delivered the highest benefit from an allocation perspective. The market sector returned in double digits and our holdings did even better in aggregate. Our relative overweight to Consumer Staples delivered good results being a sector among the top market performers. Our normal underweight to Technology also helped with that market sector coming in at the bottom of quarterly returns. On the downside, our underweight to the 2nd best performing sector, Utilities, detracted from performance.

In terms of Issue Selection, the portfolio had a great quarter, but it was far from a clean sweep. We outperformed in 6 of the 10 GICS market sectors (meaning we underperformed in 4). However, where we outperformed, we did so in a very convincing manner. The most significant contributions came from our Energy, Consumer Staples and Industrials holdings. In each of those sectors, our aggregate sector return more than doubled that earned by the market index sector. In absolute terms, our top performer was a Consumer Staples company. On the downside, we held a few stocks with negative returns, two of which were in the double digits. One of them we sold during the quarter as company management announced they were making an acquisition that we (and the market) did not find compelling. The other we continue to hold.

Speaking of selling, the quarter saw an uptick in trading activity as compared to the relative quiet of 1st Quarter. We bought three new stocks and sold outright four others. We added to three existing positions and trimmed three other positions. Additionally, we elected to retain a stock that came into the portfolio through a spin-off from an existing holding.

Quarterly Commentary

We remain entrenched to our economic outlook of Two steps forward – One and a half steps back. As we saw last quarter, there's no shortage of elements to inspire volatility in the global markets driven by geo-political tension and activity in the Ukraine, Middle East and Asia. Our economic eye continues to be wary of China, with economic reports there remaining mixed and the country still in a longer-term, downward trend. On the positive side, gradual, slow, improvement keeps appearing in Europe and we still hear more positive comments from the companies we follow there. Back in the US, a weak initial report of 1st Quarter GDP was again revised even lower to a negative 2.9%. Such a scenario fits in with the backward step scenario included in our economic outlook – even though much of the decline will likely be shown as temporary and due to the worse than normal winter. Corporate bond spreads tightened again last quarter and, particularly in High Yield, are creeping toward all-time lows, although they still have some room before getting there. While low yields and tight spreads generally bode well for the stock market, particularly Small to Mid Cap companies, we have seen in the past how quickly those winds can shift and are keeping a vigilant eye out for such signals.
