After such a great event, cats and their owners went home exhausted and looking forward to next year's event.





Once again, the Ormond Beach Police Department will have law enforcement officers participating in the Police Unity Tour.

Officer Amberly Michaelis, Sergeant Lisa Rosenthal, Sergeant Jamie Gogarty and Lieutenant Jesse Godfrey are training and raising awareness for the Police Unity Tour. They will join hundreds of other law enforcement officers from around the nation in May 2015 to participate in the Police Unity Tour, a three day, 250 mile bicycle ride from Portsmouth,

Virginia, to Washington, D.C. The Police Unity Tour is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to raising awareness about police officers killed in the line of duty, and to supporting the National Law Enforcement Officer's Memorial and Museum.

The memorial and museum, located in Washington, D.C., was established in 1984 by an act of the United States Congress and serves to honor the more than 20,000 men and women who have been killed while performing their duty as police officers within the borders of our nation. At the heart of the memorial is a blue-gray marble wall with the engraved names of all slain officers. The memorial received no government or taxpayer revenue; instead, it relies on the charitable donations of businesses, organizations and concerned citizens. As members of the Police Unity Tour, they are required to raise a minimum of \$2,000 per rider in order to participate.



Bring a lawn chair or a blanket and come out and enjoy the movie with your friends and family! Refreshments will be available for purchase.


