Employee Appreciation Day

The Florida League of Cities designated the week of October 19-25, 2014, as *Florida City Government Week*, which is part of the Florida League of Cities' ongoing effort to raise public awareness about the services that cities perform and to educate the public on how city government works.

In conjunction with *Florida City Government Week*, and in the spirit of recognizing City employees for all their hard work and dedication to making Ormond Beach the best city in which to live and work, the City Commission proclaimed October 22, 2014, as City of Ormond Beach Employee Appreciation Day. Mayor Kelley read a proclamation which highlighted that City employees are "ambassadors" who provide important and essential community services on a daily basis, 365 days a

year, 24 hours a day, during both routine and emergency situations.

City employees were provided a lunch at the Greg Smith Field House at the City's Sports Complex. The Daytona Pig Stand (located in Ormond Beach) provided a delicious barbecue lunch. Boxed lunches were brought back to employees who weren't able to attend the lunch because they were hard at work keeping the City running. Employees who were celebrating 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30 and 40(!) years of service were recognized.

"Above and Beyond" awards were presented by City Manager Joyce Shanahan to fifteen employees. These employees were given a star trophy acknowledging their above and beyond

Cracker Barrel, Peach Valley Café, and Dunkin Donuts are also eager to join the mission and scheduled future events. *Coffee with a Cop* is building a stronger community one cup at a time.

The officers from the Ormond Beach Police Department and community members will come together again in an informal, neutral space to discuss community issues, build relationships, and drink coffee provided by the establishment.

Coffee with a Cop provides a unique opportunity for community members to ask questions and learn more about the department's work in Ormond Beach's neighborhoods.

The majority of contacts law enforcement has with the public happen during emergencies and/or during emotional situations. Those situations are not always the most effective times for relationship building within the community and some community members may feel that officers are unapproachable on the street. *Coffee with a Cop* breaks down barriers and allows for relaxed one-on-one interaction.

Coffee with a Cop is a national initiative supported by the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services. Hawthorne Police Department in California was the founder of the event. Similar events are being held across the country as local police departments strive to make lasting connections with the communities they serve.

The program aims to advance the practice of community policing through improving relationships between police officers and community members.
