# Planning Department Hosts Workshop

This week the City's Planning Department planned and hosted a Community Rating System (CRS) Elevation Certificate Training Course for about 40 professionals that included professional engineers, consultants, planners and building officials. The workshop took place from December 8th through the 11th at the Anderson-Price Memorial Building at 42 North Beach Street.

Participants came from across the State of Florida and included cities such as Treasure Island, Atlantis and Tamarac, Florida. Sue Hopfensperger, a Certified Flood Manager and ISO/CRS Specialist was the trainer and participants learned the "nuts and bolts" of the proper way to complete FEMA Form 81-31 and best practices for using the Elevation Certificate in the flood-plain development review process.

Real time voting and interactive exercises were very popular according to the evaluations that were collected at the end of the workshop. Patrick Richardson, Building Official from Tamarac indicated that, "I am absolutely a better Flood Plain Manager because of the workshop and my community will benefit greatly from the knowledge."



Twelve (12) CECs for the Association of State Floodplain Managers (ASFPM) Certified Floodplain Managers (CFMs) and 30.25 American Institute Certified Planner (AICP) continuing education credits were approved for those participants that registered, attended and passed the learning objectives quiz at the end of each session that was provided.

In all, there were thirteen (13) individual sessions. Becky Weedo, AICP, CFM, Senior Planner, who organized the workshop stated, "Everyone who attended was appreciative of the course being held in Ormond Beach as opposed to going to the Emergency Management Institute in Emmitsburg, MD." Paulette Cohen, AICP and Planning Director from Treasure Island, FL, said, "the workshop was very thorough and plenty of interactive assignments that permitted active involvement by all. I am also grateful that I did not have to go to cold and snowy Emmitsburg, MD." That could be why the workshop was so well attended!!


