ADVISORY BOARD NOMINATION WORKSHOP**

December 2, 2014

5:30 p.m.

City Commission Conference Room

I. Call to Order

Mayor Ed Kelley called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m.

Present were Mayor Ed Kelley, Commissioners James Stowers, Troy Kent, Rick Boehm, and Bill Partington, City Manager Joyce Shanahan, Assistant City Manager and Public Works Director Ted MacLeod, City Attorney Randy Hayes, and City Clerk Scott McKee.

II. Discussion – Advisory Board Nominations

Advisory Board Composition

Mayor Kelley noted that the Commission had been provided with worksheets showing all of their current appointments to each advisory board, and those appointments that needed to be replaced with new appointments as the current appointments did not wish to continue serving. He explained that the Commission could not vote on the appointments at this workshop but could have discussion regarding them and try to arrive at a consensus where one was needed.

Ms. Joyce Shanahan, City Manager, stated that during the last Advisory Board Workshop, staff went through each of the boards with the Commission and took note of their appointments. She stated that those appointments would be brought back to the Commission in January at a City Commission meeting for action. She noted that if the Commission had comments about the actual advisory boards themselves, they could have that discussion at the beginning or end of the workshop. She further noted that she was aware of some comments made regarding certain boards. She explained that the Commission could not change any of the boards at the present workshop but could have discussion and provide direction for staff.

Mayor Kelley stated that the Quality of Life Advisory Board had 11 members with four who did not wish to be re-appointed. He explained that his thought was that, unless some Commissioners had appointments who really wanted to serve, they reduce the number of members on the board from 11 to seven. He noted that he had difficulty finding individuals willing to serve on that board. He stated that he had been told that the board met infrequently

Ms. Shanahan stated that one of the issues with the Quality of Life Advisory Board was that a lot of the items that they considered were also reviewed by other boards including the Leisure Services Advisory Board. She noted that the Quality of Life Advisory Board was frustrated sometimes because they did not have enough to do.

Mayor Kelley noted that he did not know if other Commission members had appointments lined up.

Commissioner Kent asked Ms. Shanahan if the Quality of Life Advisory Board reviewed anything that another board did not.

Ms. Shanahan stated that they did not. She stated that the Quality of Life Advisory Board did some historic preservation items.

Mayor Kelley suggested combining the Historic Landmark Preservation Board with the Quality of Life Advisory Board.

Ms. Shanahan commented that the Commission did not have to make a decision on combining the boards at this time.

Commissioner Kent noted that Ms. Shanahan stated that there was nothing that the Quality of Life Advisory Board reviewed that another board did not. He asked why the board was in place, if the items were already being reviewed by other boards. He noted that his two appointments did not wish to return.

Mayor Kelley stated that he had individuals tell him over the years that they would not serve on it.

Commissioner Kent stated that he liked the name of the Quality of Life Advisory Board. He stated that both boards could be combined to the Quality of Life and Historic Preservation Board.

Mayor Kelley stated that it made sense to combine the two boards and then decide how many individuals should serve on that board. He noted that some members of the Historic Landmark Preservation Board also did not want to return.

Ms. Shanahan stated that one thing that no other board did specifically that the Quality of Life Advisory Board did was to advise the Commission on ways to preserve and revitalize properties and prevent deterioration in the central business district. She stated that the scope could probably be broadened to include both functions.

Mayor Kelley noted that there were three individuals that did not wish to serve again on the Historic Landmark Preservation Board and four individuals who did not wish to serve again on the Quality of Life Advisory Board.

Commissioner Stowers stated that he did not necessarily disagree with anything said so far but was hesitant that in the context of appointing nominations to the advisory boards they were beginning to broaden the scope of the workshop to a much more impactful discussion about the future of the city's advisory boards and their makeup.

Mayor Kelley noted that they were just having a discussion as any decision would have to come back to the Commission.

Commissioner Boehm stated that he went out and found individuals who wished to be nominated to those boards to replace his vacancies.

Commissioner Stowers stated that he did the same.

Commissioner Boehm stated that now he would have to go back to them and tell them that the Commission decided the board was too large now and they would not get a position.

Mayor Kelley stated that they were asking individuals to serve and whether or not they would be willing to be nominated. He stated that the nomination did not guarantee an appointment. He noted that decision would be made in January.

Commissioner Boehm noted that the board could now be completely different than what they were asked to serve on before, or eliminated altogether.

Commissioner Kent stated that he understood what Commissioner Boehm and Commissioner Stowers were saying. He stated that he wished the Commission would have had this conversation a few weeks prior so they were not in this situation. He noted that he did not want to appoint individuals to serve on a useless board, as it would be a waste of their time. He noted that he did not attend the advisory board meetings.

Mr. Randy Hayes, City Attorney, stated that if the Commission was interested in modifying or consolidating advisory boards, they could look at it now or through the course of the next term. He stated that if they wanted to make changes to the board, they could make them effective at the beginning of the next term, so those currently appointed could serve out their time.

Mayor Kelley stated that would be two years from now.

Mr. Hayes stated that a provision could be made to have the composition of the board effective beginning at a particular date.

Mayor Kelley stated that his suggestion, if they could not arrive at a consensus that evening, would be to reserve appointing anyone to the Quality of Life Advisory Board and the Historic Landmark Preservation Board and have an open discussion at a public meeting about those boards in January or February. He noted that he did not think that anything pressing would come before either of those boards in that time frame. He stated that if the consensus was to keep those boards the same they could do so, as well. He explained that he did not promise anyone a position on a board, but told them that they would be nominated.

Ms. Shanahan stated that she was certain that Dr. Philip Shapiro, the chairman of both the Historic Landmark Preservation Board and the Quality of Life Advisory Board, would want to weigh in on the discussion of those two boards. She noted that he would want an opportunity to address the issue, and he would have attended the workshop had he thought that would be discussed this evening.

Mayor Kelley suggested moving the discussion of those two boards, and their nominations, to another date, and to continue with nominating the other boards. He stated that individuals wishing to be appointed to boards genuinely wanted to make a difference, and he felt that the feedback from individuals he asked to serve on the Quality of Life Advisory Board was that they did not.

Commissioner Partington stated that he would be in favor of holding appointments for the Quality of Life Advisory Board and Historic Landmark Preservation Board,

allowing he, Commissioner Stowers, and Commissioner Boehm to go back to their nominations and let them know that the board could be changed, and then receive input from Dr. Shapiro and others who may wish to comment.

Ms. Shanahan stated that they might be able to have more members on a combined board; whereby, Mayor Kelley stated that they may also be able to have more meetings.

Commissioner Boehm noted that their nominations could be told that the board may be combined and have a different function, and see if their nominations were comfortable with serving on that type of board.

Mayor Kelley stated that there could be more that those two boards could do if they were combined. He noted that it also reduced staff time with staff attending the meetings.

Commissioner Stowers stated that he had conversations with individuals regarding appointments to the Quality of Life Advisory Board and Historic Landmark Preservation Board. He stated that he thought that the subject matter of the Historic Landmark Preservation Board, which he served on, ebbed and flowed. He stated that he told his nomination that the board only met six times last year. He stated that was one of the reasons to merge the boards together. He noted that he was not opposed to that concept but just had wanted to note before that he thought that this workshop was solely to discuss nominations not the scope of the advisory boards. He asked if it should be broadened to include other boards, noting that he had similar issues with other advisory boards. He stated that he would be open to a larger discussion, sooner rather than later.

Mayor Kelley stated that they wanted to make the individuals that serve feel like they were serving a purpose. He suggested holding off on the appointments to the Quality of Life Advisory Board and Historic Landmark Preservation Board and then having a workshop in January to discuss in further detail how to move forward with those boards.

Commissioner Boehm stated that Dr. Shapiro could attend that workshop and provide his perspective as the chairman of both boards as to how well they would integrate. He asked when they were supposed to make their appointments.

Mr. Hayes noted that there was an ordinance but also no penalty for not appointing timely.

Ms. Shanahan suggested that the workshop could be held before the first City Commission meeting in January, which was on January 6, 2015.

Aviation Advisory Board

City Clerk Scott McKee stated that the only member that did not wish to continue to serve was Mr. Larry Volenec. He stated that Mr. Volenec had been appointed by Zone 1 Commissioner.

Commissioner Stowers stated that he spoken to Lieutenant Colonel Joseph Wisniewski, who was a retired commercial airline pilot with an airplane at the airport.

He stated that he wanted to nominate Lt. Col. Wisniewski for his Zone 1 appointment to the Aviation Advisory Board.

Board of Adjustment and Appeals

Mayor Kelley stated that his alternate appointment, Mr. Bruce Teeters, did not wish to continue to serve. He noted that Commissioner Kent's alternate, Ms. Sue Parkerson, did not wish to continue to serve and that Commissioner Boehm's alternate appointment, Mr. Dana Smith, did not wish to continue to serve. He noted that he served on the Board of Adjustment and Appeals for four years himself as an alternate and was only called once. He stated that he felt that there were enough alternates.

Commissioner Kent stated that he did not have anyone to nominate. He noted that Mr. Scott Selis was interested in serving but was unsure if he would want to serve as an alternate; whereby, Commissioner Boehm stated that he was going to also nominate Mr. Selis.

Mayor Kelley directed staff to put Mr. Selis down as Commissioner Boehm's Zone 3 nomination for alternate member of the Board of Adjustment and Appeals.

Brownfield Advisory Board

Mayor Kelley noted that all of the current members of the Brownfield Advisory Board wished to be reappointed.

Budget Advisory Board

Mayor Kelley noted that Ms. Kathy Weston was elected judge and her appointment would need to be filled as she could no longer serve. He stated that her appointment had been by Commissioner Stowers.

Commissioner Stowers nominated Mr. Scott Cichon, who was an attorney and a certified public accountant (CPA), for the Zone 1 appointment to the Budget Advisory Board.

Citizens' Law Enforcement Advisory Board

Mr. McKee stated that Mr. Josh Mead, who was appointed by Zone 1, resigned because he moved out of the city limits, and that Ms. Margaret Sharifi, appointed by Zone 2, did not respond to the inquiry about her interest in continuing.

Commissioner Stowers nominated Mr. Jeremy Buckmaster for the Zone 1 appointment to the Citizens' Law Enforcement Advisory Board.

Commissioner Kent nominated Mr. Matthew Pittman for the Zone 2 appointment to the Citizens' Law Enforcement Advisory Board.

General Employees' Pension Board

Mayor Kelley noted that all of the current members of the General Employees' Pension Board wished to be reappointed.

Historic Landmark Preservation Board

Mayor Kelley noted that the appointments for the Historic Landmark Preservation Board would not be nominated that evening, per their earlier discussion about the possibility of changing or merging the Historic Landmark Preservation Board and Quality of Life Advisory Board.

Mayor Kelley noted that the two vacancies for that board were at-large appointments.

Human Resources Board

Mayor Kelley stated that the only member of the Human Resources Board that had indicated that they did not wish to continue serving was Mr. Bob Henry, the Zone 3 appointment.

Commissioner Boehm nominated Ms. Kay Garcia for the Zone 3 appointment to the Human Resources Board.

Mayor Kelley noted Mr. Rick Fraser's position as the Executive Director of the Ormond Beach Chamber of Commerce ("Chamber") and stated that he thought that it would not be a conflict for him to continue serving on the board despite it.

Mr. Hayes stated that the Chamber was not affiliated.

Ms. Shanahan noted that the city did provide funds to the Chamber.

Mr. Hayes asked if those funds were a stipend.

Ms. Shanahan stated that the city had a contract with the Chamber to provide relocation packet services.

Mr. Hayes stated that he did not think that was an issue; whereby, Ms. Shanahan agreed.

Leisure Services Advisory Board

Mayor Kelley noted that all of the members of the Leisure Services Advisory Board indicated that they wished to continue serving, except Mr. Tim Moore, who was appointed by Youth Soccer.

Municipal Firefighters' Pension Board Trust Fund

Mayor Kelley noted that all of the members of the Municipal Firefighters' Pension Board indicated that they wished to continue serving.

Neighborhood Improvement Advisory Board

Mayor Kelley stated that two members of the Neighborhood Improvement Advisory Board did not wish to continue to serve. He stated that those members were Ms. Andrea Hall, the Mayor's appointment, and Mr. Troy Railsback, Zone 1 appointment.

Mayor Kelley stated that he did not have a nomination for this board. He stated that if any of the Commissioners had the name of an individual who would like to serve, he would be glad to nominate them.

Commissioner Kent stated that he had not spoken to this individual about serving on this board, but Ms. Margaret Sharifi may be willing to serve. He noted that she had not responded about continuing to serve on the Citizens' Law Enforcement Advisory Board and might need a change.

Commissioner Stowers nominated Mr. Matthew Shapiro for his Zone 1 appointment to the Neighborhood Improvement Advisory Board.

Planning Board

Mayor Kelley noted that all of the members of the Planning Board had indicated that they wished to remain serving. He asked if anyone had any changes on their appointments, noting that he had some changes he wished to propose.

Commissioner Partington stated that Ms. Rita Press had asked him if he would reappoint her to the board and he told her that he would. He explained that he told Ms. Press that before he knew that Mr. Harold Briley, who was currently an at-large appointment, wanted him to appoint him. He stated that he would be willing to appoint Mr. Briley, if Ms. Press was appointed to the at-large position. He noted that he gave Ms. Press his word that he would nominate her for appointment again and that she had served for 11 years. He stated that the current board got along well and worked together well.

Commissioner Kent stated that he wanted to make sure that Mr. Briley would continue in the at-large position.

Mayor Kelley stated that he had two new names to submit for the at-large position that had indicated a willingness to serve. He noted that he was unsure appointments could be guaranteed. He stated that he personally felt that he would like to see Ms. Press removed from the board. He noted that he was the only member of the Commission who openly opposed her appointment four years prior. He stated that there would be a review of the Land Development Code (LDC), and he thought it might be beneficial to have some new members to take a fresh look at some of the things that would be brought before them. He stated that he would be in favor of removing Mr. Doug Wigley from one of the at-large appointments, noting that he was first appointed by Mayor Kelley in 1993. He stated that he thought it may be time for some fresh eyes to review some of the upcoming issues.

Commissioner Kent asked Commissioner Partington if he would be willing to nominate Mr. Briley for the Zone 4 appointment and submit Ms. Press for consideration as one of the at-large appointments.

Commissioner Partington indicated that he would probably not be willing to do so. He reiterated that he told Ms. Press that he would nominate her again for the Zone 4 appointment.

Mayor Kelley stated that he could not support Ms. Press' nomination, noting that he would likely be the only one to feel that way.

Commissioner Partington noted that Mayor Kelley had not supported it before also.

Mayor Kelley explained that the reason he did not support Ms. Press' appointment was her attack on Ormond Beach during her foreclosure information presentation. He noted that the actual numbers were not reflective of those presented by Ms. Press. He stated that Ms. Press presented the information in a negative way.

Commissioner Kent stated that he could easily lean the same way Mayor Kelley was thinking. He stated that the night of the vote he may also say "no" because he had similar issues. He noted that he appreciated Commissioner Partington being a man of his word.

Commissioner Stowers noted that most of the time the appointments were unanimous. He asked what would happen to the rest of the appointments for that board if it was voted against because of one individual member.

Mr. Hayes stated that there could be an underlying motion to adopt the resolution for the entire board and then individual appointments could be discussed separately and treated as an amendment.

Ms. Shanahan asked if the appointments made by specific zones of the Mayor were the decision of just the appointer or if those appointments were voted on.

Mr. Hayes stated that historically it was nominated by a specific Commissioner or the Mayor and then approved by the Commission as a whole. He noted that there had been some precedent in the past where an appointment or nomination did not win the approval of the Commission.

Ms. Shanahan asked if a nomination failed, for a specific Commissioner or the Mayor's appointment, if it would go back to that specific Commissioner or the Mayor to make a new nomination.

Mr. Hayes stated that it would.

Commissioner Kent stated that the precedent had been set before where votes were taken on individual appointments. He noted that he was leaning towards Mayor Kelley's position on appointing Ms. Press.

Commissioner Partington stated that he would be keeping Ms. Press as his nomination for Zone 4. He stated that if there was an issue with her nomination going through he would deal with it then.

Mayor Kelley nominated Ms. Lori Tolland for one of the at-large appointments to the Planning Board. He noted that Dr. Daniel Drake also wished to serve and could be considered for an at-large appointment.

Commissioner Boehm stated that he would nominate Ms. Tolland for consideration, as well.

Commissioner Kent noted that Mr. Wigley expressed interest in continuing.

Mayor Kelley reiterated that he felt that it was time for a change.

Commissioner Kent nominated Mr. Briley to be re-appointed for one of the at-large positions.

Commissioner Boehm stated that Mr. Wigley was chairman of the Leisure Services Advisory Board and would continue in that capacity. He noted that Mr. Wigley would continue to serve the city.

Commissioner Kent stated that Mr. Briley was a thoughtful person who researched the issues and had done an excellent job.

Mayor Kelley stated that he watched Mr. Briley lead one of the meetings.

Commissioner Kent stated that if Ms. Pat Behnke had not worked so hard for him all through the years, he would be willing to nominate Mr. Briley for his Zone 2 appointment.

Commissioner Boehm noted that the Mayor had submitted Ms. Tolland and Dr. Drake for consideration and asked him which of those two he would prefer.

Mayor Kelley stated that he would prefer to nominate Ms. Tolland. He stated that she had expressed a direct interest in serving on this board.

Commissioner Boehm stated that he agreed with the nomination of Ms. Tolland and Mr. Briley.

Commissioner Kent stated that the consensus seemed to be Ms. Tolland and Mr. Briley for the at-large appointments.

Mayor Kelley stated that a lot would be expected out of the Planning Board in the coming times. He noted that he wanted some changes, suggestions and ideas brought to the Commission to eliminate some of the impediments that the city may have concerning economic development in the LDC. He stated that would take a lot of work and dedication on the part of the Planning Board.

Commissioner Boehm stated that he did not know Mr. Brian Nave but noted that he had also expressed interest in serving on the Planning Board. He noted that in the event that one of the nominations did not pass, he could potentially be submitted for consideration.

Commissioner Kent stated that he would be appointing Mr. Nave to the Public Works Advisory Board.

Ms. Shanahan confirmed the consensus was Ms. Tolland and Mr. Briley for the at-large positions on the Planning Board.

Mayor Kelley suggested that if Commissioner Partington's appointment of Ms. Press did not succeed then maybe Mr. Briley could move to become Zone 4's appointment, which would leave an opening at the at-large position which could be filled by Mr. Wigley or Dr. Drake.

Commissioner Stowers noted that he did not know that there were possibilities of open positions on the Planning Board. He explained that he had talked to an

individual about serving on the Quality of Life Advisory Board, but since they were holding off on that board, this individual may be interested in serving on the Planning Board. He stated that the individual was Mr. Tim Davis, who was a realtor who formerly lived in Daytona Beach and had served on the Daytona Beach Planning Board. He stated that Mr. Davis was someone who could serve and was forward thinking and progressive.

Mayor Kelley stated that there were probably a dozen quality individuals in the city willing to serve on the Planning Board.

Public Works Advisory Board

Mayor Kelley stated that Mr. Joe Lipscomb, the Mayor's appointment, and Mr. George "Sandy" Dunn, the Zone 2 appointment, did not wish to continue to serve on the Public Works Advisory Board.

Mayor Kelley nominated Mr. Bob Coleman as the Mayor's appointment to the Public Works Advisory Board. He noted that Mr. Coleman was an engineer.

Commissioner Kent nominated Mr. Brian Nave as the Zone 2 appointment to the Public Works Advisory Board.

Ms. Shanahan asked if Mr. Nave was an engineer.

Commissioner Partington stated that Mr. Nave worked with robotics.

Commissioner Boehm stated that the requirements stated that the individual should be involved in civil engineering, structural engineering, electrical engineering, stormwater engineering, contract administration, architecture or general contracting.

Commissioner Partington suggested that robotics could be structural or electrical.

Mayor Kelley stated Mr. Nave's robots used to battle each other on a television show. He stated that Mr. Nave was very creative.

Commissioner Stowers asked if there was a scenario where Mr. Nave would not meet the requirement.

Mr. Ted MacLeod, Assistant City Manager and Public Works Director, stated that Mr. Dunn was an insurance agent and Mr. Eugene Miller, who also served, was a former City Manager.

Mr. Hayes stated that those requirements were suggestions for members to the extent that members with those traits could be found to serve.

Ms. Shanahan stated that it certainly sounded like Mr. Nave would be qualified.

Mayor Kelley stated that there were civil engineers on the board and that Mr. Coleman was also a civil or electrical engineer.

Commissioner Kent stated that the board also needed appointments with common sense.

Quality of Life Advisory Board

Mayor Kelley noted that the appointments for the Quality of Life Advisory Board would not be nominated that evening, per their earlier discussion about the possibility of changing or merging the Historic Landmark Preservation Board and Quality of Life Advisory Board.

Goodwill Ambassador Program

Mayor Kelley stated that he felt it was fine to have three appointments for Goodwill Ambassador.

River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization

Mayor Kelley nominated Commissioner Stowers to serve on the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization. He nominated Commissioner Boehm to serve as the alternate member.

River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization – Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC)

Mayor Kelley noted that Ms. Gayle Belin had asked him to be appointed to this committee. He stated that the BPAC was a difficult committee to serve on. He noted that the right person could make a difference and that Ms. Belin was very interested.

Ormond Beach Main Street, Inc. Board of Directors

Commissioner Boehm noted that he had served on the Ormond Beach Main Street Board of Directors for two years and would like to keep serving.

Commissioner Kent noted that he and Commissioner Stowers each served on that board for two years and he would have served if Commissioner Boehm did not wish to do so.

Closing Comments

Mayor Kelley stated that yesterday was the first meeting of the Round Table of Volusia County Elected Officials.

Commissioner Kent congratulated Mayor Kelley on being elected chairman.

Mayor Kelley noted that he did not see any other boards he thought would be compatible to be combined and discussed at the future workshop, other than the Quality of Life Advisory Board and Historic Landmark Preservation Board.

Mr. McKee clarified that there would be a workshop held before the January 6, 2015, City Commission meeting to discuss the Quality of Life Advisory Board and the Historic Landmark Preservation Board.

Mayor Kelley stated that any appointments made at that meeting would need to be added to the January 6, 2015, agenda the same evening.

Ms. Shanahan stated that those nominations could be added to the January 20, 2015, agenda.

Commissioner Stowers noted that those two boards met at different days and times.

Ms. Shanahan stated that the boards chose their own meeting dates and times.

III. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 6:28 p.m.
