

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, from the moment of their founding in 1882, charity has been the first principle of the Knights of Columbus. The Order is still true to its founding principles of charity, unity, fraternity, and patriotism; and its service programs are designed to establish each council as an influential and important force within the community; and

WHEREAS, the history of the Order shows how the foresight of Father Michael J. McGivney brought about what has become the world's foremost Catholic fraternal benefit society. The Order has helped families obtain economic security and stability through its life insurance, annuity and long-term care programs, and has contributed time and energy worldwide to service in communities; and

WHEREAS, the Knights' charitable activities encompass an almost infinite variety of local, national and international projects. From international charitable partnerships with Special Olympics and the Global Wheelchair Mission to their own Coats for Kids and Tootsie Roll Campaign for Disabled Citizens projects, and other purely local charities, like Habitat for Humanity, Council on Aging Meals on Wheels, and Emory L. Bennett Memorial Veterans Nursing Home--the opportunity to work together with fellow Knights and their families is virtually endless; and

WHEREAS, the Knights of Columbus has grown from several members in one council to more than 14,000 councils and 1.8 million members throughout the United States, Canada, the Philippines, Mexico, Poland, the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, Panama, the Bahamas, the Virgin Islands, Cuba, Guatemala, Guam and Saipan; and

WHEREAS, the Prince of Peace Knights of Columbus Council 8791 is located at the Prince of Peace Catholic Church in Ormond Beach, Florida, at 600 South Nova Road. The Council was chartered in 1984 and its 215 members work closely with the Prince of Peace Parish, providing funds for various parish projects, social services for the needy, vocations for our seminarians, and assistance to our veterans and the disabled by our members being active participants in our parish and community; and


WHEREAS, today we celebrate the 30th anniversary of the Knights of Columbus Prince of Peace Council 8791;
