Memorial Day Remembrance Service

Hundreds of men, women and children will gather in Rockefeller Gardens on Monday, May 25th, in loving memory of those whose supreme sacrifice protect the privileges we enjoy as a nation. Our debt can never be paid as acknowledged by the increasing faithful citizens and visitors each year who attend the Memorial Remembrance Services.

Weeks of preparation by the volunteer Memorial Remembrance Committee and City staff each year has made this an increasingly popular and widely respected event.

Dignity, respect and love describe the humility with which this annual program is presented. The uncompromised purpose is to honor the selflessness and bravery with which over a million men and women throughout our history have laid down their lives for our freedom.

Ninety minutes of heart grasping sights and sounds will fill Rockefeller Gardens starting at 9 a.m. when Charles Long conducts the members of the Daytona Beach Concert Band.

Victoria Leignadier, Colonel, US Army (retired), will serve as the Memorial Remembrance moderator.

Attendees will be welcomed by The Honorable Ed Kelley, Mayor of Ormond Beach.

The invocation will be rendered by Rabbi Howard Schwartz, US Army Major (retired) and the benediction by Chaplain Willie Branch.

Symbols of liberty will overflow into every corner of Rockefeller Gardens as numerous military color guards and color corps enter and assume their positions. Additional groups, including Boy and Girl Scouts will join them.

Guest speaker for the 2015 event is Captain Mark Leary, United States Navy. Captain Leary, a native of Worcester, Massachusetts, earned his Navy commission through Aviation Officer Candidate School in 1982. After completing flight training, he was assigned to Helicopter Combat Support Squadron Eight (HC-8), in Norfolk, Virginia, flying the H-46D Sea Knight helicopter and deployed aboard USS Kalamazoo (AOR 6). After a subsequent deployment aboard USS Sylvania (AFS 2), he was assigned to the Fleet Replacement Squadron, in San Diego as an Instructor Pilot.

Following training in the UH-1N, helicopter, he reported as Aircraft Handler aboard USS New Orleans (LPH 11), and deployed for Desert Shield/Desert Storm. In 1992, he reported as a student at the Naval War College graduating with distinction. He was then assigned to HC-6 in Norfolk as Detachment Officer in Charge onboard USNS Saturn (T-AFS 10) and USNS Concord (T-AFS 5) and as the Squadron's Maintenance Officer. In 1996, he reported to the Pentagon as a Legislative Liaison to the Congressional Defense Appropriations Committee. After screening for operational command, he reported as Executive Officer then Commanding Officer of Helicopter Combat Support Squadron FIVE (HC-5) in Yigo, Guam.

In 2001, Leary reported as Navigator of the aircraft carrier USS John F. Kennedy (CV 67) and deployed to the North Arabian Sea where JFK and Airwing Seven conducted air strikes in Afghanistan for Operation Enduring Freedom. In September 2005, after screening for major command ashore, Captain Leary reported as Commander, U.S. Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, supporting U.S. Southern Command's Global War on Terror Detention Mission. In 2009, he assumed Command of the Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps (NROTC) Unit at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University (ERAU) where he commissioned over 130 Navy and Marine Corps officers. Captain Leary is the president of the Halifax Chapter of the Military Officers Association.

Guests will be given a carnation on arrival at Rockefeller Gardens. A final tribute is rendered as they move forward in procession, to place their flower beside the Memorial Marker as a personal "thank you" to those who made the supreme sacrifice. As the last flower is placed, we the free will have honored the fallen with love, humility and gratitude.

This annual Memorial Remembrance Service takes place at 9 a.m. on Monday, May 25, at Rockefeller Gardens, 26 Riverside Drive in Ormond Beach. Rockefeller Gardens is at the southeast corner of Granada Boulevard (State Road 40) and Riverside Drive on the peninsula side of the Granada Bridge, and in front of The Casements. Parking will be available at The Casements, Fortunato Park, and the Ormond Memorial Art Museum. In the event inclement weather threatens the outdoor festivities, the service will be held inside the City Commission Chambers, located in City Hall at 22 S. Beach Street.
