
## PARKS



The Leisure Services Parks staff made repairs to the fire truck play apparatus at the Magic Forest Playground and repaired the children's swing at the Boundless Playground at the Sports Complex. Over at Central Park I, graffiti was removed from the restroom walls, and a vandalized soffit was repaired. A new parking stop was installed in the parking lot at Fortunato Park, and broken glass was cleaned from under the bridge at Bailey Riverbridge Gardens. A lock on a toter was replaced at Joyce Ebbets Pier, and the low hanging limbs were trimmed over the sidewalk on Hand Avenue.

As usual, Citywide safety inspections were performed of all parks and equipment and weekly inspections were done of parks facilities for reservations.
