Corporal Gaden Receives Recognition

On June 18, 2015, Corporal Michelle Gaden received recognition for her efforts in the rescue of Prescott, who was found at the bottom of a Tampa hotel pool.

Earlier this year, Corporal Gaden and her family were staying at a Tampa hotel for a Pee Wee football game being held in the area. While poolside at the hotel, Corporal Gaden noticed a young boy on the bottom of the pool and yelled for her fiancé to pull him out. Once on the pool deck Corporal Gaden, and a nurse who was also present, started CPR. The boy, whose name is Prescott, is a member of a football team that was visiting the hotel when he was rescued.

The City of Tampa Police Department Police Chief presented Corporal Gaden, her fiancée David, the assisting nurse and football coach with a Citizen's Appreciation Award for all of their efforts they put forth to save young Prescott's life.



CAP Cadets Attend Color Guard Academy

Cadets from the Ormond Beach Composite Squadron of the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) recently attended the Florida Wing Color Guard Academy at Patrick Air Force Base. Cadet Tech Sergeant Corey Spitz, Cadet Senior Airman Andrew Weiker, and Cadet Chief Master Sergeant Devon Giles, members of the squadron's Southeast Region Champion Color Guard Team, were present to serve as instructors for the two day event. The squadron's new color guard team, Cadet Airman Benjamin Bauder, Cadet Staff Sergeant Leigha Bauder, Cadet Chief Master Sergeant Shane Fitzgerald, and Cadet Senior Master Sergeant Joel Lohman, trained alongside other cadets from across the state in preparation for the Florida Wing Color Guard Competition on August 14, 2015.

In addition to preparing for competition, the Ormond cadets frequently present and post the national colors at City events, such as the annual Memorial Day observance at Rockefeller Gardens. The cadets were escorted at the academy by Lieutenant Kevin Demarco, Lieutenant Mark Thibodeau and Captain Andrea Giles.


