Civil Air Patrol Wins State Competition



The Ormond Beach Civil Air Patrol Cadet Color Guard Team competed against six other teams and won seven trophies, including first place overall, at the 2015 Florida Wing Cadet Competition on September 14-16 at Patrick Air Force Base.

The cadets competed in a series of events, including an indoor and outdoor drill, physical fitness, team leadership, public speaking and military-style inspection. They also had to complete a comprehensive written exam and compete in a fast-paced quiz game on Civil Air Patrol and

aerospace knowledge, similar to the game show "Jeopardy."

Under the leadership of Capt. Mark Thibodeau, Capt. Gositha Dewage, 1st Lt. Kevin DeMarco and 1st Lt. Andrea Giles, the cadets practiced tirelessly for many hours each week for two months preceding the event in preparation to compete. As a result of their victory at the state competition, the Ormond Beach cadets will represent the entire Florida Wing at the 2015 Southeast Region Cadet Competition to be held this October.




Movies on the Halifax

Moving Rating: "Annie" is a PG rated movie. Parental guidance is suggested as some material may not be suitable for children.




Say Goodbye to Summer

FLOW is a standalone mobile office with technology to provide most motorists' needs. It provides drivers license/ID card change of address, renewals, replacements, and renewals and replacements of vehicle registration and disabled parking permits, as well as other needs. The only thing FLOW does not provide is for the drivers' license road test.

FLOW brings services to the local communities offering a convenience to citizens while saving them time and gas.

Electronic Plan Review (ePlan) notice

- * **Effective October 1, 2015, all building and site plans requiring a design professional are required to be submitted electronically.**
- * **Informational meetings held on August 26th and September 24th at 10am in the City Commission Chambers.**
- * **On September 14th, individual appointments to learn how to submit project are available by calling (386)676-3311.**

Purpose:	The City of Ormond Beach has been working to implement an electronic plan review (ePlan) for building permits and site plan applications.
Why the City of Ormond Beach is implementing ePlan:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Elimination of paper submittals. 2) Reduce production costs of paper submittal. 3) Faster review time by City staff. 4) Ability for multiple City staff members to review concurrently. 5) Comments provided directly on plan sets. 6) Ability by design professionals to respond quickly and only to affected sheets. 7) Long term storage of applications.
What submittals are required to use ePlan:	Any building permit or site plan that requires a design professional, such as an architect or engineer.
When are ePlans required to be submitted:	On <i>October 1, 2015</i> all building plan and site plan submittals are required to be submitted using the ePlan system. No paper submittals shall be accepted for projects requiring a design professional.
How can I learn to use the ePlan system:	<p>Staff shall have the following informational sessions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * August 26, 2015 - 10am, City Commission Chambers. * September 14, 2015 - individual appointments available. Please call (386) 676-3311 for an appointment time. * September 24, 2015 - 10am, City Commission Chambers.
Can I submit ePlans now:	Yes, the ePlan system is operational and applicants can submit electronic plans now.
