

Two teams from each of the states in the Southeast Region journeyed to Albany, Georgia, to compete in this event. The State Champion Ormond Beach cadets teamed with their fellow cadets from the Coral Springs Cadet Squadron to represent the State of Florida and competed against other teams from Alabama, Mississippi, and Tennessee.

The Florida teams won first and second place overall at the competition, and earned the right to represent the Southeast Region at the CAP National Cadet Competition in December. Ormond Beach and Coral Springs will travel to Maxwell Air Force Base in Alabama to compete with other cadets from across the United States for the national title. From six to nine o'clock, The Casements hosted its sixth annual Rockefeller Revisited event on the North Lawn and within the historic home. Set eighty-four years in the past, the night's festivities transported visitors back to the oil tycoon's heyday!

Once guests arrived at The Casements, an antique Ford automobile ushered visitors back to October 24, 1931. Haunting chamber melodies, courtesy of local woodwind quintet Opus 5, welcomed invitees as they awaited their tours. Between chilled apple cider, tasty ginger snaps, and tales from characters, there was never a dull moment!

When the time arrived to tour the home, Mr. Rockefeller's housekeeper Miss Lillian invited groups to see the abode's elaborate decorations! As guests traversed the first and second floors via candlelight, Miss Lillian introduced them to historical figures, such as Henry Ford, Mrs. Fanny Evans, General Ames, and Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Price. Houseguests even met Mr. Rockefeller, who awarded each person one of his signature dimes and a goodie bag filled with treats!

People of all ages were invited to attend the historical reenactment tours. Children were encouraged to look for Mr. Rockefeller's misplaced orange-colored items, which included a top hat, pocket watch, and a pair of glasses to name a few! Each child who participated received a Cracker Jack snack, and one lucky champ won a Halloween gift basket filled with lots of tricks and treats!

The most people to date attended this year's Rockefeller Revisited event. Without the help of The Casements Guild and local volunteers each year, Rockefeller Revisited would not be possible.
