

# Police Chief Candidates

Once Police Chief Henry “Andy” Osterkamp announced his retirement after 33 years with the Ormond Beach Police Department, the City had partnered with STARS, the executive search program of the Florida Police Chiefs Association to recruit and screen candidates. The City received 90 applicants for the position and five candidates were selected to participate in an assessment day.



On Monday, The Casements served as the location for the Police Chief candidates assessment and reception. Candidates, panelists, and City officials arrived at 7:00 a.m. After breakfast, the day kicked off with a welcome by City Manager Joyce Shanahan, which was followed by an orientation, panelist interviews and tours of the city.

After lunch, each candidate was involved in a town hall exercise to see how they would respond to questions posed to them at a commission meeting. At the end of the day, the panel members selected three finalists: Captain Robert “Jesse” Godfrey, Ormond Beach Police Department; Deputy Police Chief Vincent Pryce, City of Melbourne; Police Chief Jason Umberger, Swatara Township Police Department (Harrisburg, PA).

That evening The Casements, gilded with ivory and gold, housed a reception for the candidates. From 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., City officials, staff, and community members met the final three candidates. Approximately 100 attended the evening’s public gathering, and guests enjoyed hors d’oeuvres from Amber’s Jewel Catering, refreshments, and lively conversation.



In the days leading up to the event, City staff worked diligently to prepare for the assessment. Human Resources worked hard throughout the recruitment process and The Casements staff set up seating and table arrangements, and created an inviting atmosphere for the guests.


