FLOW Mobile

The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles "Florida Licensing On Wheels" (FLOW) mini mobile unit will be at City Hall, 22 South Beach Street, on **Tuesday, July 19, from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.** The mini mobile unit will be **located in the Atrium** which is inside the building and adjacent to the City Commission Chambers.

FLOW is a standalone mobile office with technology to provide most motorists' needs. It provides drivers license/ID card change of address, renewals, replacements, and renewals and replacements of vehicle registration and disabled parking permits, as well as other needs. The only thing FLOW does not provide is for the drivers' license road test.

FLOW brings services to the local communities offering a convenience to citizens while saving them time and gas.




OPEN GYM
