➤ **Economic Stimulus Program**

On Wednesday of last week, I attended a professional development workshop in Orlando to earn Continuing Education Units toward renewal of my Professional Engineer License. The meeting was held to discuss County-wide coordination for the upcoming economic stimulus program.

➤ **Starry, Starry Night**

➤ **Naviline Upgrade to Version 6.0**

Over the MLK Holiday weekend, the IT staff completed the upgrade of the City's Central Computer system to the latest version available by the vendor Sungard Public Sector. This updated version contained many fixes and several enhancements including the ability to attach documents to various processes. The IT staff will evaluate the impact of implementing this feature on the City's current data storage capacity and expects to only implement this feature on a limited basis until the storage area network is implemented later this year as part of the Document Management project.

➤ **MAC Charter FBO 2 Project**

MAC Charter, Inc., is moving ahead at full speed with the largest private development project ever undertaken at the Ormond Beach Municipal Airport. Principal construction of the facility is expected to be complete in late March of this year, and strong interest in the project is already being felt within the aviation community. Located on Hangar Way in the southeast quad of the airport, the new facility adds 33 T-hangars and 4 large box hangars to the field, and represents the latest and most up-to-date complex of its kind in the area. The MAC Charter FBO 2 project, when completed, will be of great benefit to business and general aviation activity in Ormond Beach.
