## DARE Graduation



Yesterday, Mayor Partington attended the D.A.R.E. graduation at Tomoka Elementary School. Mayor Partington spoke to the audience of 126 students about the importance of making the right choices and resisting harmful influences.

Also present to celebrate with the students were parents, school staff, City Manager Shanahan, Police Chief Godfrey, Captain Crimins, Sergeant Elkins, Officer Dovine, Officer Brennan, Police Accreditation Manager Rick Gaylord and Victim Advocate Evelyn Rebostini.

The D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) program is a structured ten-week program where uniformed police officers teach fifth grade students the life skills they need to avoid involvement with drugs, alcohol, violence, and bullying. D.A.R.E. was founded by the Los Angeles Police Department in 1983.

Prevention education programs such as D.A.R.E. play a major role in teaching the dangers and consequences of substance abuse. Like other prevention efforts, D.A.R.E. plays an important role in supporting families, positive peer groups, and communities in order to raise healthy, responsible youths. D.A.R.E. is a model of "Community-Based Policing" at its best. The program stimulates positive interaction between virtually all members of the community.

The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles "Florida Licensing On Wheels" (FLOW) mobile unit will be at City Hall, 22 South Beach Street, on **Tuesday, December 13, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.**

FLOW is a standalone mobile office with technology to provide most motorists' needs. It provides drivers license/ID card change of address, renewals, replacements, and renewals and replacements of vehicle registration and disabled parking permits, as well as other needs. The only thing FLOW does not provide is for the drivers' license road test.

FLOW brings services to the local communities offering a convenience to citizens while saving them time and gas.


