Lori Tolland- The arbors will be completed by October 1st at Vadner Park. The Garden Club will pick up in the Fall. The upkeep of the park is gorgeous. Under Leisure Services for the CIP funded projects, there were only parking lot items and not anything to do with parks and recreation.

Doug Wigley- Fall baseball numbers are high. 86 kids signed up for T-Ball, 100 for machine pitch, 83 girls playing softball.


