

Hand Avenue Collector Road Upgrade Project Update

November 30, 2012

As we enter into December and the holidays, Hazen Construction is making good progress towards their goal of having the paving complete from Nova Road east to Oakbrook Drive by Christmas.



As of Monday, December 3rd, all of the utility work from Stratford Place through the midpoint of Oakbrook Drive will be complete. On Monday the contractor will begin road construction in this area and will mill the remaining asphalt from Stratford Place to just east of the Park Place entrance. As a result, traffic patterns will fluctuate and change over the next 3 weeks. This means at times local residents will only be able to enter/exit to and from the east and at other times only to the west as directed by the flagging crew. Please allow additional travel time to reach your destination.

Upon completion of the base course through Park Place, the road base work will be done from Park Place through the midpoint of Oakbrook Drive. When that is completed, the road will be paved from Stratford Place to Laurel Creek along with all of the restoration work. We appreciate your cooperation and patience and our goal is to have this area paved prior to Christmas as previously mentioned.
