**ROLL CALL**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Vice Chairman, Rev. Willie Branch. Those present were Ed Shumaker, Kevin Tilley, Lt. James Crimins, Chief Henry Osterkamp, and recording secretary Chris Beatty. Chairwoman Margaret Sharifi was absent and unreachable by phone. This meeting was a rescheduled meeting of the May 15, 2013 cancelled meeting due to lack of quorum.

## **Internal Affairs Investigations:**

IA 12-016 – Officer was found to be in violation of the Pursuit Policy and not giving accurate and truthful testimony of the facts regarding the incident. Officer was terminated due to this and other investigations. No further discussion was held.

IA 12-017 – Volusia County Officer complained that an officer (same as 12-016) had been interfering with a DUI investigation being conducted by VCSO. No further discussion was held.

IA 12-018 – An Ormond officer was believed to have violated DHSMV policy by running a DAVID inquiry and making a printout. Investigation revealed the charges against the Ormond officer were unfounded. Use of DAVID was explained by the Chief and the board was informed that the purpose for running David has become more restrictive with there being more severe consequences for misuse. No further discussion was held.

## **Supervisory Inquiries**

SR 13-001 – Complaint against an officer for not doing what he was supposed to while investigating an accident. Investigation exonerated the officer. No further discussion was held.

## **Vehicle Pursuits**

VP 13-001 Routine radar traffic stop and then driver took off at high rate of speed. Short pursuit, radio description of vehicle and direction of travel. Foot pursuit upon locating suspect, unfired Taser, cuffed and arrested.

VP 13-002 Traffic stop during STEP. Suspect requested to pull vehicle into station but he kept going. Second officer engaged in and stopped short pursuit but suspect was witnessed going through a red light crashing into other vehicles. He was caught and arrested

All vehicle pursuits were found to be in compliance.
