**APPROVAL OF MINUTES from August 28, 2018**

Mr. Pittman made a motion to approve the minutes as written; seconded by Mr. Kimble. All were in favor; motion passed unanimously.

**DISCUSSION:**

Section 1 Internal Affairs: Mr. Tilley asked if the same officer was involved in both IA cases presented here and if there was any other process change. Chief answered, "yes", the same officer was involved in both IA cases and approximately 2 years ago we implemented a process whereby the Officer wanted to forego the Internal Affairs investigation and basically acknowledge wrong doing, it would speed up the process. Mr. Shumaker asked when an officer resigns like that, would FDLE (Florida Department of Law Enforcement) pull his Police Certificate. Chief answered, "no" and the officer could technically apply to another agency. A CJSTC 78 form is completed and forwarded to FDLE notifying them an internal investigation has been completed.

Section 2 Response to Resistance Reports: UF18-038, Mr. Shumaker asked what charges were filed against the subjects? Captain Smith responded the driver was given a citation for tailgating and the passenger was charged with resisting without violence.

UF18-039; Mr. Tilley asked if the subject was Baker Acted and Sergeant Pavelka responded, "yes, he was". Chief noted a discussion was held with PD Supervisors and noted the subject should have been charged with the felonies committed, he was also under the influence of a narcotic. Checked with State Attorney's office and was told voluntary intoxication is not a defense.

UF18-046; Mr. Tilley commented on man inside residence loading a handgun. An RPO (Risk Protection Order) was filed with the court based on risk of violence.

**OPEN DISCUSSION:**

Mr. Tilley noted he had the opportunity to participate in a Ride-A-Long and asked the other board members if they had. Mr. Shumaker has participated twice in the past. Mr. Tilley thought it should be made mandatory for board members to participate within the first month. Mr. Tilley rode with Officer Feeley and experienced a domestic disturbance, possible speeding violation, incident at a home with the *RING* doorbell, STEP procedure, had a conversation with a homeless person, call made to a citizen notifying him his car had been recovered and dealt with a confused driver. Overall, the experience was professional, polite, displayed integrity and handled all situations carefully. Looking forward to participating again.
