**DISCUSSION:**

Section 1 Internal Affairs:

18-009 In this case, an officer disposed of a citizen's property at the direction of a supervisor. Mr. Shumaker asked if the type of punishment followed by the department is progressive discipline. Chief responded yes. Mr. Shumaker asked if the officer involved in this case was the same officer initially contacted by the complainant. Captain Smith responded this officer was the officer who dealt with complainant during his original arrest. Mr. Shumaker noted he finds it hard to understand why an officer would receive

a verbal reprimand for complying with a Supervisor's directive. Chief Godfrey responded that the officer received the verbal reprimand because the officer did not remedy the situation. The Supervisor received a written reprimand.

**OPEN DISCUSSION:**


