

What is Enviro Camp?

Enviro Camp is designed for children ages 7-10. Camp runs for two, four-week sessions and meets from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. *Please note: Camp will not be held during the 4th of July week (July 2nd– 6th).*

Enviro Camp uses games, crafts, and activities to teach kids about the environment, nature, history, science, and more!

Campers are asked to bring a snack, drink, and a lunch each day. Please do not bring any personal belongings, such as cell phones or toys, to camp. We will provide drawstring backpacks to each camper; we ask that you bring these bags each day instead of backpacks. Campers will also receive a free t-shirt, which we ask that they wear on fishing days.

Thanks to Fish Florida, campers will receive a free fishing pole & fishing lesson on Wednesdays. Campers will receive one pole per session they attend.

Session One

June 4th - 8th

"Talk to the Animals"

The backyard botanists will identify local trees on nature walks, sprout a green thumb in the Community Garden, grow their own plants and have an "unbe-leaf-able" good time!
