Hello Neighbors-

We are so excited that the Museum renovation and construction project is complete, and your Ormond Memorial Art Museum is reopening to the public after 16 months!

The Museum and Gardens would like your input. We are applying for a Special Exception Development Order to allow two things.

- The first is to allow an additional donor recognition sign on the southwest corner of the new building facing South Halifax Drive. The sign would recognize the generous financial gift of a local donor to underwrite adding 7 additional butterfly art pieces to that wall. The same butterflies are currently on the south-facing wall of the building. Response has been so positive that we would like to add more in the second location so that more people can enjoy their beauty. The purpose of this sign would be to honor the donor who makes it financially possible.
- The second is to request the ability to offer outdoor music on the rooftop terrace during museum events and private receptions between the hours of 11 AM and 10 PM. Museum staff would always attend these events and monitor sound to be certain that it conformed to existing city codes.

We would like to invite you to a neighborhood meeting to discuss these two requests and hear your input. The meeting will include a sound test so that you can hear exactly what we are requesting and will be Thursday, May 19 at 5 PM at the Museum. The purpose of this meeting/sound test is to demonstrate that any music would comply with the allowable decibels as outlined by the City of Ormond Beach.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 386.26F>S>, persons needing accommodations or an interpreter to participate in this meeting should notify the City no later than 48 hours prior to the meeting by contacting the City Clerk's office at 386-677-0311.
